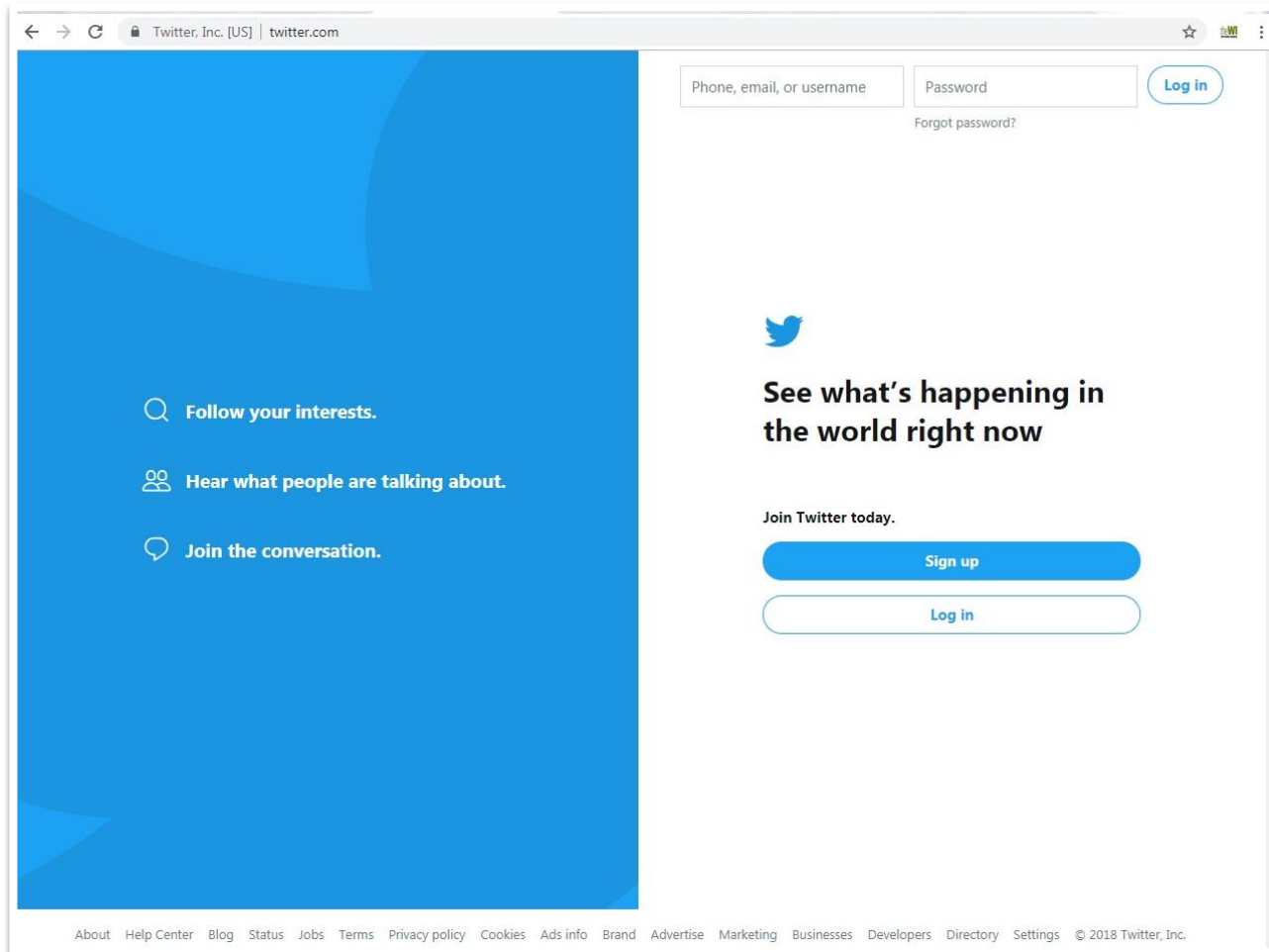



How do I set up my Twitter page?


Step 2: Sign up using your name and email address

Step 3: Make your preferences or click 'next' if you would not like any of the following





Step 4: Create a password for your account





Step 5: Choose your interests or 'skip for now'



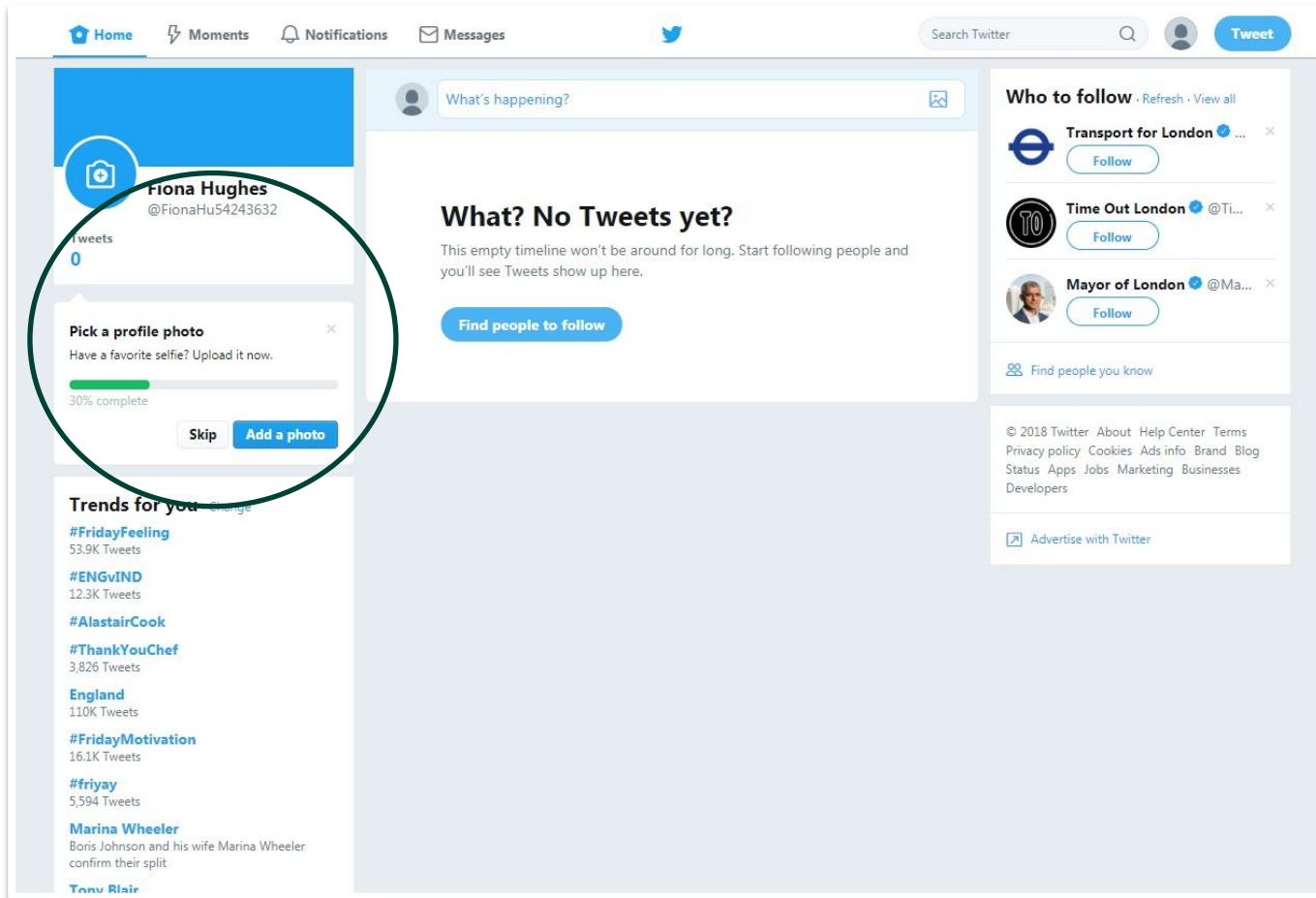

Step 6: Start working on your Twitter profile



Pick a profile photo, this could be your federation logo

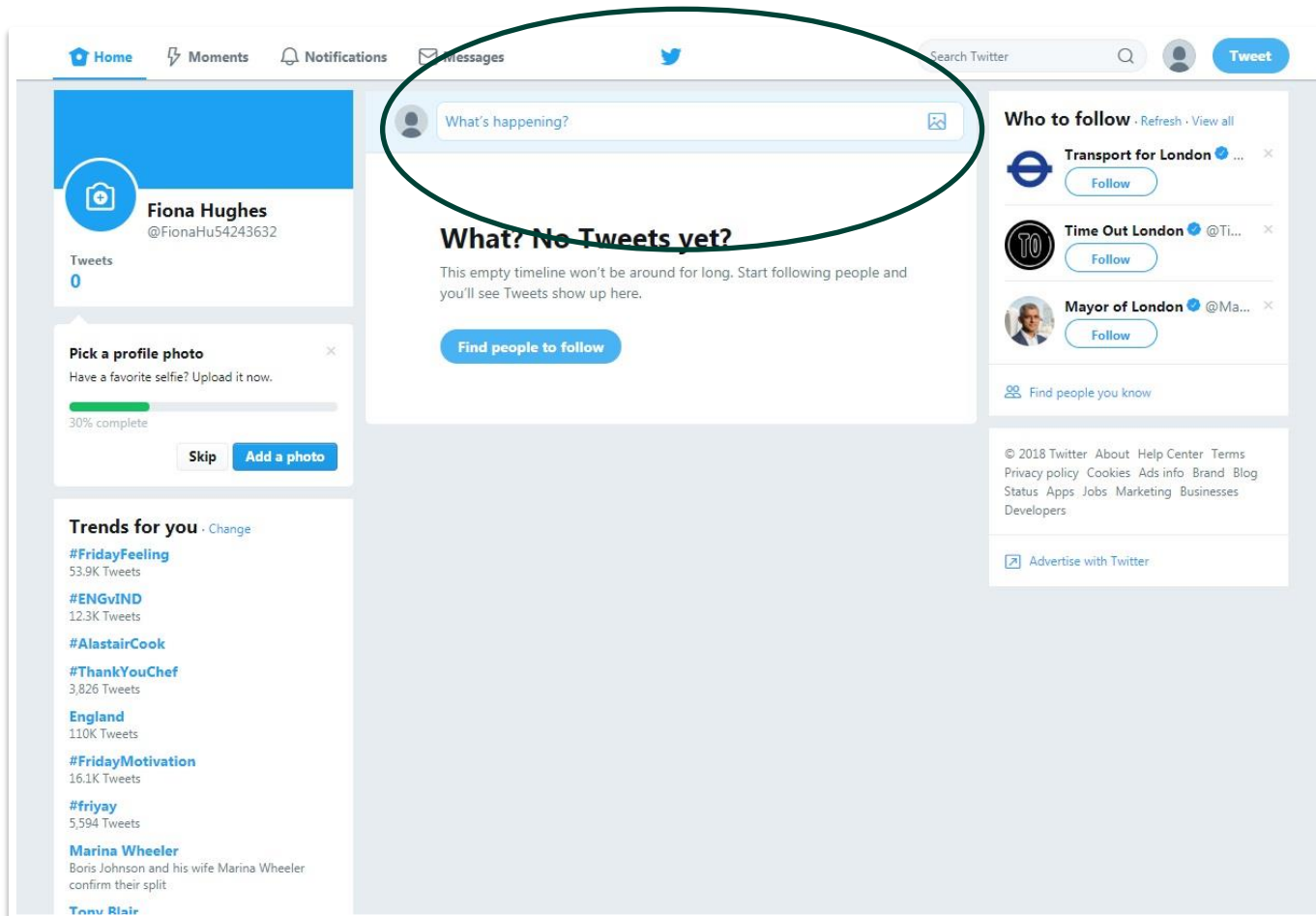
Add a bio to your Twitter profile to explain who you are

Start following accounts you are interested in – some suggestions come up at the side

Find other federations and WIs to follow

How do I set up my Twitter page?

Step 7: Start Tweeting!



Start writing tweets in the box at the top which says 'What's happening?'

A tweet is limited to 280 characters

You will not be able to post your tweet if you exceed 280 characters

The left hand box is what topics are trending on Twitter, users create trending topics with hashtags

If a hashtag is relevant, use it in your tweet to get more visibility for your profile
